ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
THE NEBRASKA FIELD TRIAL ASSOCIATION, Inc.

Article 1. Name: The name of the organization shall be the Nebraska Field Trial Association, Inc.

Article 2. Existence: Established in 1972, this association of pointing dog clubs shall serve its membership in perpetual existence, governed by its Constitution and Bylaws. The business of the corporation shall be conducted by the Board of Directors at regular and special meetings called for this purpose.

Article 3. Purpose: The purpose of the organization shall be: (a) to unite pointing breed clubs who have a mutual interest in the preservation and development of Nebraska's state field trial grounds;

(b) to cooperate in providing licensed field events for pointing dogs on state, regional, and national levels;

(c) to maintain the association's lodge for the use of member clubs during field trials, hunting tests, and seminars; (d) to assist the game commission in maintaining the natural habitat conducive to the propagation and lawful hunting of game birds;

This corporation is organized exclusively for these and such other charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article 4. Income: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its member clubs, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.

Article 5. Legislative or Political Activities: No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Article 6. Operational limitations: Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation except from Federal Income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or (b) y a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article 7. Dissolution: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the liabiliti

corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purpose of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
